Work was completed 2017 for the extension of the existing Horizon Nuclear Power Wylfa Newydd site office; work carried out included all groundworks associated with the installation of prefabricated units to extend the overall footprint of the office.

The installation of a 62,000-litre cess pit with all temporary works designed and carried out by ourselves. All excavation work, concrete design and pour for the ground-level base of the new offices units to be installed onto, all blockwork for pillars and all associated ground work, steps and landscaping. This project was carried out on a design and build basis for Elliott Group Ltd on behalf of Horizon Nuclear Power. The programme was completed on time and within budget.

The offices are now occupied by staff from Horizon Nuclear Power.

This was a challenging, constructed building in a densely populated area. Construction comprised piled foundations, with concrete ground beams and pre-cast ground flooring. The remainder of the building was sustainably considered, constructed from a timber frame structure, external wall timber cedar cladding, recycled plastic roofing, high volume of insulation, aluminium windows and doors, recycled plastic/wood perimeter decking, ground source heating, solar panels to heat water, rain-water harvesting and specialist equipment.

Construction period: 22 weeks

Work will start on major projects in locations including the centres of Swansea and Pontypridd

Disney are planning a €2bn (£1.75bn) expansion of Disneyland Paris.

The multi-year project will transform Walt Disney Studios Park and see the addition of three new areas based on Marvel, Frozen and Star Wars, along with other new attractions. The multi-year development will roll out in phases beginning in 2021, with a significant expansion of the Walt Disney Studios Park.
